Our LGBTI Aged Care System Navigator, based in Cairns, can work with you to navigate:

- The types of services and support available - in home or residential
 - The My Aged Care portal
 - How to access aged care services
 - Your rights and responsibilities
 - How to compare services, facilities and prices
 - Other options if you are on a waiting list
- And much more.

We also work with local agencies to assist in the provision of culturally safe, LGBTIQ+, Sistergirl and Brotherboy inclusive services.
